

NATIONAL SAFETY COUNCIL (KERALA CHAPTER)

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AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN SAFETY MANAGEMENT

(FOR REGISTERED FACTORIES IN KERALA)

1. This award is for the registered factories situated in Kerala having the most excellent safety management systems, programmes and practices.
2. The organisation contesting for this award should have no fatal accident and should have an average accident frequency rate of less than 5 cumulatively during the past 3 years (2016-2018).
3. They should not have received any show cause notice from the Department of Factories and Boilers/Electrical Inspectorate/Pollution Control Board/Petroleum and Explosives Safety Organisation/ Labour Department/ any other statutory body or punished by any court of law for any violation of safety aspects during the past 3 years (2016-2018).
4. Should not have any instance of gas or liquid effluent leakage crossing boundry of the factory during the last 3 years
5. The contesting organisation should give a write up (not more than 10 pages in Arial font 12) of 20 most important safety management systems, programmes and practices they are having along with the application form.
6. Based on the information in this write up, organisations will be short listed and they will be called for presentation before the judging committee on a venue and date decided by the Chapter.
7. A three member team consisting of the Officer in charge of Safety, a worker representative of the Safety Committee and another person from the organisation should make a 15 minutes presentation followed by clarification session of about 5 minutes. All the three should be involved in the presentation.
8. The Judging committee will decide the winner after evaluation of presentation and clarifications.
9. The contesting organisation should submit their application by duly filling and signing the following format by Occupier/Factory Manager.
