MANDATORY TRAINING FOR HAZARDOUS INDUSTRY SUPERVISORS

Sub: Certificate Course for supervisors employed in Hazardous Process Industries under section 41-C (b) of the Factories Act, 1948

Ref: Order No. G.O.(Rt)No.1411/2018/LBR Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 13.12.2018 of the Additional Secretary to the Government, Labour and Skills (B) Department, Government of Kerala

I. INTRODUCTION:-

As per section 41C(b) of the Factories Act 1948, it is the specific responsibility of the Occupier to appoint competent supervisors for supervising the handling of hazardous chemicals and as per Kerala Factories Rule 81AN they are required to undergo a specialized training on Health and Safety approved by DGFASLI/ State Government. We are glad to inform you that National Safety Council-Kerala Chapter has received the approval of Government of Kerala vide the reference quoted above to conduct this training. The syllabus followed for this course is as stipulated in the guidelines issued by the Directorate General Factory Advice Service and Labour Institutes (DGFASLI), Government of India.

II. QUALIFICATIONS:

The applicants should have the following qualifications.

- (a) (i) A degree in chemistry or a diploma (three years full time) in any branch of Engineering or technology or equivalent with not less than 5 years' experience;

OR

- (ii) A master's degree in chemistry or a degree in any branch of engineering or technology or equivalent with not less than 2 years' experience.

- (b) The experience stipulated above shall be in process operations and maintenance, in any hazardous process industry.

III. DURATION:-

The duration of the course shall be as follows:

5 Weeks full time course from 9.00 am to 5.00 pm [three weeks class room teaching followed by one week project work and on completion of which a further one week classroom teaching] as per DGFASLI guidelines

The course is scheduled to commence on **Monday, 6th September 2021** and to conclude on **Saturday, 9th October 2021**

If classes could not be conducted on any day as scheduled due to any reason, the training gets extended to such number of days.

IV. ARRANGEMENTS:-

Class room training in A/C hall, Study materials, nearby Factory visit, Occupational Health and Industrial Hygiene Lab Visit, Food & refreshments during training will be provided by NSC-KC. The participants will have to make their own arrangements for stay, if required.

It may be noted that this course provides the Statutory Training stipulated under Factories Act, Sec. 41C [b] and Kerala Factories Rule 81AN and is mandatory for the supervisors employed in hazardous processes.

You are requested to nominate your supervisors who are required to undergo this training at the earliest to comply with the provisions of the statutes. **Due to the COVID-19 REGULATIONS, the number of seats is limited to 20 for a batch.**

Nominations with name, address and qualification of participants and two passport size photographs may please send to the office on or before **1st September 2021**.
